

Host Family-The Language Room 12-18 years old-2 weeks stay English and general activities course

As a Host Family you would be responsible for providing bed and breakfast and letting them be part of your family in the evenings and one day on the weekend.

The students will be attending English course from 9am until 5.30pm from Monday till Friday. The student arrives on the Sunday prior to the start of the course (time varies depending on their flight) and leaves on the Saturday (time varies depending on their flight) after the end of their course, leaving one week-end of which one day will be spent with the host family and the other day discovering Scotland with The Language Room.

Students will be healthy and fit to take part in all the activities offered by The Language Room. We always try to match students the best possible with the host families.

The Language Room is always available to offer support and help to both the host family and student if required (a 24 hours contact number will be given to you on the student's arrival).

What benefits to you and your family:

For young children, their new big brother or sister may be their first exposure to another language, different customs, and ways of thinking. These early experiences teach tolerance and can spark a lasting interest in world history, geography, and language.
